Why Are We Funding The Grantmaking Opportunities Program?

This program area offers a variety of funding opportunities to a broader universe of non-profit service providers to improve the quality, scope and delivery of mental health services.

What is the Goal of This Program?

The goal of this program is to provide funding opportunities to all governmental agencies and non-profit organizations that provide mental health care and services in southeast Michigan (Wayne, Oakland, Macomb and Washtenaw). One year grants will be awarded ranging from \$25,000 to \$50,000 to address the following objectives:

- Public information, awareness and education campaigns that combat negative stigma attached to mental illness.
- Public policy research to improve delivery of mental health care and services
- Organizational capacity building that will improve mental health service delivery and treatment outcomes
- Screening, assessment, diagnosis, and intervention relating to early mental health treatment
